


How to make Book Attack cards from the PDFs


1

Print out all the pages of the PDFs onto A4 sheets of paper. Print on one side only.





Take each sheet and fold it in half along the length of the sheet and make a crease along the fold.

Cut longways along the crease. (If you don't have scissors tear along the fold using a ruler to make the tear straight).

You should now have two long sheets of paper.

Fold each piece of paper in half and glue or tape the two blank sides of the paper together.

Fold again to make booklet. The questions or instructions should be on the inside and the title and the pattern should be on the outside.

There should be a total of 204 cards.



How to make the Book Attack board from the PDF

Print out the the Book Attack board onto two A4 sheets of paper and glue the two sheets to a piece of cardboard.
